The Travel Ball season runs from August 1st, through July 31st. We will be asking all families to submit all required paperwork (listed below) within 48 hours of receiving this email. All players new or returning are required to electronically sign at the appropriate places within this document. By doing so you are acknowledging that you have read and agree and understand all BPA terms and conditions. No player will be allowed to start with their team until this document, along with player registration fee(s), uniform package payment and player(s) first month dues have been submitted.

Team dues for Players Includes:

1. One weekly field practice
2. One Weekly BPA indoor facility practice
3. 15% discounts on all equipment in the 5Tool Athletics Hitting Center
4. Up to 25% off on all Wilson products purchased through BPA's exclusive Online Team Store. Products include all Louisville Slugger, Demarini, and Evo Shield gear

Not included in team dues:

1. Local and out of state tournaments fees. Most BPA tournament level teams will travel out of state at least 1-2 times a year. Any other out of state tournament is up to the coaching staff and the parents on that team, fees are TBD.
2. Scrimmages are \$20 for home games and away fees are TBD but will rarely exceed \$20.

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Monthly Dues

After this document is signed and sent back you will receive an email from us asking you to set up your account (if you do not already have one) in QuickBooks. QuickBooks ACH electronic check processing is the method we use for annual registration, monthly dues, tournament fees and local scrimmage fees.

What is an ACH Payment?

ACH stands for "Automated Clearing House," which refers to an electronic network that can process payments in batches. BPA uses ACH payments for a few reasons:

- Member convenience
- Paper reduction
- Easier tracking for our members
- Eliminates unnecessary bookkeeping steps for our members

This process is completely safe and private!!

All invoicing for monthly dues will go out on or about the 20th of every month via email. Monthly team dues will need to be paid on or before the 1st of every month.

There are penalties for those who fail to pay their monthly dues on time.

- 1-10 days late: \$10
- 11-15 days late: \$20
- 16-30 days late \$45

All player(s) over 30 days will be removed from the roster until the account is brought current.

Annual Payment

If you so choose you can pay your dues up front you will receive one month free.

Sibling Discounts Monthly Dues

\$25 off per player, per month, **no** reduced registration fee

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BPA Uniforms Package

****Please Read This Section Carefully!!****

Your players uniform packages will need to be purchased on the “BPA Oder My Gear Store”. **This team store/ordering period is only open for one week no exceptions! The store will be open on August 7 and will close on August 14.** If you do not order your uniform package during this period, we (BPA Staff) can’t guarantee that your player will have a uniform prior to the start of the season.

During this ordering period, you will also be able to order any other gear that your player may need for the upcoming season. This is one of the few times throughout the year that you will be able to take advantage of up to 25% off on Wilson products. Again, this is exclusively only for BPA team members

To begin practicing prior to September 1st with the team, all following actions below must be completed:

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Parent Code of Conduct

Parents will:

1. Obey all rules and regulations of BPA and the various Travel Leagues and organizations of which BPA participates
2. Get their players to practice and games on time. (15 min before practice, 1hr-before game time)
3. Remember that players play baseball for their enjoyment, not their parent's enjoyment!
4. Do not publicly question an umpire's judgment, the umpire's decision as final
5. Accept the coaches' decision regarding playing positions and the amount of playing time and also understand that this is a Travel Team and there are no guarantees for equal playing time or position
6. Understand that BPA reserves the right to release any player from the team for poor sportsmanship by the player and/or the player's family during games or for other reasons to include but are not limited to lack of cooperation, poor attitude, lack of commitment, lack of effort, or poor attendance
7. Understand that any ejection of a player and/or a family member from a game will result in a two (2) game minimum suspension for the player and/or family member
8. Understand that if a player is dismissed from practice the coach has the discretion to suspend the player for a minimum of 2 games
9. ****Do not give the players any instructions during the game, no exceptions!!**
10. ****Do not enter the dugout or other team specific areas unless asked by the coaching staff, if you need to give your player food or drink during a game you will hand it to a coach and the coach will hand it to your player, no exceptions!!**
11. Understand that coaches may impose additional rules, guidelines and/or policies that I am required to follow and failure to comply with the rules, guidelines and/or policies is a violation of your commitment
12. If there is a problem/conflict with the coaches, parents **will not approach them during or after a game.** Instead they will obey the "24-hour Rule" call the coach/BPA management to discuss.
13. ****"The No Drama Clause" All parent/guardian issues or concerns regarding playing time, coaching, player positions, other players' performance shall be directed toward an appropriate representative within the BPA organization. Any discovery and confirmation of a parent/guardian participating in or instigating conversations that are negative and/or that attempt to denounce the recommendations/practices of the BPA organization, will immediately be asked to exit the program. Under no circumstance is it appropriate to discuss the performance of a player who is not your child, EVER!!**

**I have read the Parent Code of Conduct and I fully understand and agree to all the rules. Furthermore, I acknowledge that it is my responsibility for all family members and non-family members to be briefed and adhere to the above code of conduct.
